

INDIANA CHAPTER PRIDE/CHAPTER DRESS DISPLAY

OBJECTIVE:

To display acceptable Chapter colors and outfits or event theme that might identify a particular Chapter in a non-riding setting or when vests might not normally be worn.

GENERAL RULES:

Each participant must be a GWRRA member at the time of display.

A Chapter must consist of a minimum of four (4) people.

This category does not include any music or routines. Chapters shall identify themselves and do ¼ turns so that the spectators can see the members all four (4) sides. Chapter may want to state the approximate attendance at the Chapter's Monthly Gathering "participation factor".

Chapter wear must include the GWRRA patch OR the words Gold Wing Road Riders Association OR the letters GWRRA.

Chapter wear will be the generally accepted colors of that participating chapter.

Chapter wear must identify the particular chapter by letter. Chapter name may also be displayed, if appropriate.

Chapter wear should identify the particular individual by name (name tag).

This program will not be a competition. This is for each chapter to show their chapter wear and let the other chapters know their accomplishments for the past year.
