

WINTER RENDEZVOUS GRAND PARADE GUIDELINES

1. There will be two (2) categories – Walking or Float entry. Float entries may have members walking with it. Walking Entries can not have any type of float involved.
2. Float entries must be no larger than 5 feet wide and 6 feet 8 inches tall; this is a door size restriction. Length must be reasonable so all entries will fit into the parade route. **NO MOTORIZED FLOATS!** Floats must be pulled or pushed by the chapter members. This is a safety issue/requirement.
3. Floats do not need to be “lighted” but should follow the theme of WR.
4. All entries **MUST** be ready **BEFORE** the scheduled start of the parade.
5. Winners will be selected by judges appointed by the Indiana Team.
6. Each Chapter entry **MUST** have the following:
 - A. GWRRA emblem or the words displayed.
 - B. Chapter letter/designation displayed.
 - C. Theme prominently portrayed.

Entries will also be judged on Creativity, originality, continuity, enthusiasm, showmanship and presentation.
