

INDIANA GWRRA TRAVELING PLAQUE PROGRAM

GUIDELINES

1. *This program must remain for the purpose of Chapter Visitation and for the fun of all Chapters and members.*
2. *To claim the traveling plaque there must be at least five (5) **MEMBERS**.*
 - a. *Mileage, not the total number of Members will determine the Chapter that claims the plaque if more than one Chapter is in attendance.*
 - b. *In the event of a tie in mileage, then the total number of **MEMBERS** will be the deciding factor.*
3. *A Chapter cannot immediately reclaim the plaque. There must be at least one Chapter take possession of the plaque between them and the Chapter that took it from them unless the plaque goes unclaimed for more than three meetings and at the earliest it can be reclaimed at the fourth meeting.*
4. *The plaque can only be claimed at a **Chapter Meeting**.*
 - a. *If you have the plaque, please notify the place of business where you hold your meetings that you may have several guests.*
 - b. *Make other Chapters aware that you have the plaque by any means possible. Newsletters are a good means if you get yours out before your meeting.*
 - c. *Report any change concerning your meeting date, place, time, etc... Report it to your District Director.*
5. *Please add your Chapter name and the date to the plaque as soon as you take possession of it.*
6. *You are responsible for the plaque, so we ask that you take good care of it and be sure to take it to your meeting to be claimed by another Chapter. (It might save you a trip home to get it.) We hope you enjoy the program and that it will be beneficial to your Chapter's treasury. We also hope you will encourage your members to share in the privilege of meeting many more of our Indiana GWRRA family.*
