Rider Education:**Leathers REALLY are worth the price!**

With the colder weather now here, the odds are that many of you have begun wearing leather chaps and heavier jackets while riding. Though pretty expensive, there's ample proof that these provide far more than protection from the cold.

In studies of “survivability” of various garment materials to a 50 MPH ride on asphalt, for example, denim lasted no more than FOUR FEET before wearing through. KEVLAR, on the other hand, lasted EIGHTEEN FEET.

But standard motorcycle quality (about three times heavier than fashion jacket material) lasted EIGHTY SIX FEET. That’s more than 20 times as effective as you jeans in protecting your hide.
