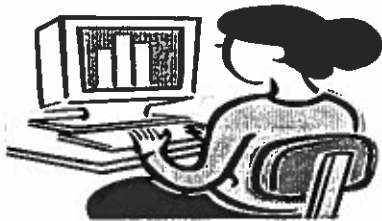

Rider Ed:

A lot of riders out there, aren't paying attention to the weather reports, and not riding accordingly. In this **HOT & HUMID** weather, riders are not hydrating (drinking liquids) while on longer rides. When it is hot like this, everyone needs to drink plenty of liquids constantly. Coffee, sodas and caffeine drinks are actually some of the worse liquids to take.

Everyone needs to recognize the symptoms of heat stress, exhaustion, and even heat stroke. If a person has ever been a heat casualty, they are more prone to future heat stress, than someone who has not. At a minimum, we should stop at least each hour, and drink a quart of water, Gatorade, PowerAde, etc. Most people will complain that if they drink that much, that often, they will be going to the bathroom constantly. **THAT** is the point. If you are not urinating frequently enough, **YOU** are dehydrated. Also watch the color of your urine, the darker it is the more dehydrated you are.

HELLO everyone!

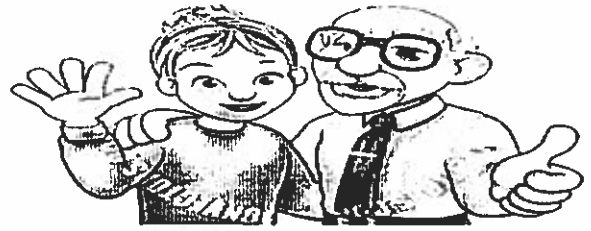
It is hard to believe that it is already July, WOW!

Trevor, who was a little boy in her class, came walking up to her from the back of the room. He stood with his hands on his hips and said loudly, 'I'm not free. I'm four.'

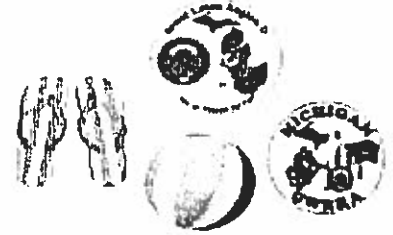
