Just a few things I have heard about recently...be aware of your surroundings

*Someone comes to your door claiming to be from a utility company. They ask you to walk your property to show them where the lines are...meanwhile, another person is going through your house...Beware...the utility company should know where their lines are.

* You get any call from anyone claiming that you are being sued for something or you owe money (taxes traffic ticket etc). This is something you would receive in the mail. DO NOT Give out any banking info or any other personal information.

* Some people on Face Book have recently been hacked. They get a message or text from someone that they DO KNOW. However, this person is asking for money. Always be suspicious, before you send anybody any money...be sure you know who is really asking. Give the person a call to confirm they really sent the message.

* You place an ad to sell something. You get a call or text from someone who is really interested. They want to send you a check for more than you are asking. Don't be fooled. If you cash the check...they will have access to your account.
